



The Esthetician program training can be a physically and mentally stressful activity. The purpose of this information is to help ensure that students are medically capable of performing the following tasks or working under the following conditions:

- Spend six to eight hours standing or walking
- Touch hair or skin of client's body (both female and male)
- Good hand-eye coordination and fine motor skills
- Recommend that you are willing to report and receive immunizations

How do the hours work in the esthetics program work?

You will attend a lock step class during the first half of your program. During this time, you will learn all services that fall under this licensure. (Facials, Manicures, Pedicures, Waxing, Chemical peels, Body treatments, Lash and brow tinting etc.) Once you have completed your class time you will then go on to the floor to complete clinical hours. (Esthetician: Skills= 240 hours Clinicals= 360 hours; Masters Skills=300 hours Clinicals=300 hours)

What happens if I have to miss class?

Basic Esthetics, are permitted to miss 6 absences (3 hour blocks) per class (esth 1, esth 2)

Master Esthetics, are permitted to miss 7 days per class (3 hour blocks) (Master esth 1, Master esth 2)

Clinicals you are permitted to have 10 absences per year (July to July)

When class time is missed you will be required to purchase a block of time to make the hours you missed up.

How do clinical hours' work?

You will be allowed to select your schedule for the clinical floor. You will be required to attend a minimum of 15 hours per week and maximum of 40 hours per week. The times available to attend are 9-12, 12-3, 3-6, 6-9. You may have a different schedule every day but each week will be the same. It will cost \$10 to change your schedule.



Am I required to bring in models?

Yes. During class time you will have a variety of models that you will be required to bring in. These services will be given to models at half price. These model dates and prices will be given to you on the first day of class during orientation.

What happens if I am at school but don't have a client?

You will be allowed to work on Student-to-student. You will also be able to take clients from the salon. We also encourage everyone to promote themselves to start building a clientele.

Are Eyelash extensions taught during this course?

After you complete your skill classes an eyelash extension course is offered as an elective class. This is a 15-hour course that you will receive an eyelash extension certificate from.

Are Kits required?

All of our required items are listed on the Davis Tech website.

These items can be purchased from the bookstore before class begins. ***The kits are required to have on the first day of class.***

Why do I need Immunizations? Immunizations – Are Strongly Recommended

Prior to participating in a clinical rotation at the (Davis Tech Salon & Spa located at the Davis Hospital), Davis Tech requires that students:

1. Provide documentation of **current** (annual) screening for tuberculosis by an intradermal PPD test or TB skin test. If you show positive PPD/TB, you must show proof of adequate medical work-up and proof that tuberculosis is currently not communicable (chest X-ray report, physician, or health department written note) can receive it at Davis Hospital at no or limited cost.
2. Provide documentation of Chicken Pox immunization or receive related immunization.
3. Receive current flu shot (can receive it at Davis Hospital at no or limited cost)
4. **Note:** Parents or guardians of minor students have the right to waive this requirement, but you must fill out a Hepatitis B Waiver. Adult students are not eligible for this waiver.***

Why is there a Licensure?

Utah (and all states) have rules on who can work on your skin, hair, or body to make sure that safe practices are involved. It is against the law to practice without a license. You may get a license at 600 hours for a basic esthetician. You will need an additional 600 hours to receive your master's licensure. Basic esthetician or Cosmetology license are prerequisites to a master esthetician license.



Do I need a SSN to get my Esthetics license? Notice Regarding Utah state licensure

This program leads to a Utah state licensure that requires a valid Social Security Number (SSN). You will not be able to work in this profession in Utah, unless you have a SSN. For more information, you may visit the following government websites:

Why are there fees for Student-to-Student Services and/or Model Work?

Students will be required to provide models or be a model, during their training in the esthetician (or related programs) and there are costs associated with each service beyond the dollars spent on supplies within their kits. (Please look to the end of the document for price lists).

Please keep in mind that as a professional Esthetician or Master Esthetician you will need to charge for your services regardless of if you work for yourself or a company. This is part of the process of building a clientele start now by booking friends while you are learning and then expand to new faces as you build your skills.



How can I lower my costs/fees \$\$\$ in my program?

Student-to-Student Services Costs –

- Costs assume you will use some product from your kits (cleanser, toner, nail product, related items, etc.) to prep skin before add-ons such as a chemical peel (costs include add-on products beyond your kit).
- Costs include all disposables (this could include files, pedi-liners, flip-flops, paper products, hair color, chemicals, etc.)
- May include a portion of linen costs (towels, sheets)

Additional ways to reduce some of your costs:

- Buy an Esthetics Disposable kit at the bookstore – items are bought in bulk and are priced cheaper than they can be purchased on your own.
- Work Smart:**
 - Use your time effectively – check in with the front desk at the beginning of your floor time each day and let them know you are available to take walk-ins.
 - Start booking friends and family the first week of your clinicals for your required services so they can set aside time in their calendars to come and see you.
 - Don't book student-to-student services on busy days – it reduces your chance to get a paying client. If you do, be prepared with a back-up student to finish the student-to-student service if you get pulled away for a paying customer.
 - Look at the most expensive student services and look for an outside guest that can pay – so you don't have to.
 - If you have concerns that you don't know enough people to book all your required services talk with your instructors to get ideas. To build a clientele – you will have to reach out by phone, text, email, and social media to friends, family, friends of friends, Davis Tech employees who work in all departments, co-workers, and folks you don't know. It is what will make you valuable as an entrepreneur or an employee.

A former beauty student incurred \$0.00 costs coming through the Davis Tech program by following these principles. She now owns a salon in the Salt Lake Area, employs 3 other esthetics professionals and is booked through the rest of year using the same techniques she developed as a student to book her first clients. *It is possible, and it can be a great way to start your own business or get an employment offer at the spa of your choice if you already have a client book to add to the business.*
